The Madison County 310 Board is hosting the Department of Mental Health for a presentation on the new Community Waiver Program. In November of 2021, the Department of Mental Health released the Community Waiver Program in 11 counties in Alabama. Madison County is a pilot county, so the Community Waiver program is the only Waiver available to new enrollees for services for individuals with Intellectual Disabilities. The Department of Mental Health will be present to share information about the Community Waiver for individuals currently on our waiting list for services, those enrolled in the Community Waiver Program, and those that are interested in applying for the waiting list for services. 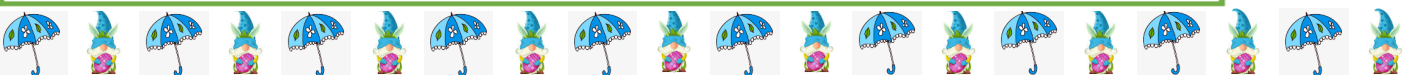
