- 1) **Alabama RxCard** www.AlabamaRxCard.com
 - Qualifications (see website for more details):
 - ✓ No age or income requirements
 - ✓ No personal information required to receive card
 - Program covers brand and generic medications at discounted price
 - ✓ Savings up to 80% (average savings around 30%)
 - ✓ Over 68,000 participating pharmacies
 - ✓ Free Card activated online
 - No cost to enroll, no restrictions

 - Qualifications (see website for more details):
 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ No age requirement
 - Medications provided at no cost to patient
 - Coverage is limited to Astra-Zeneca products
 - Cannot be used with commercial insurance or Medicaid patients
 - Can be used with Medicare patients
 - 1 year enrollment, can re-enroll annually if still eligible
- 3) **COVID-19 Prescription Assistance Programs**
 - **Paxlovid** [Pfizer AssistRX-Paxcess] 877-450-4412 www.paxlovid.iassist.com
 - ✓ Must be 12 years of age or older
 - ✓ Patient and pharmacy must be enrolled
 - ✓ Medication can be mailed to patient if no local participating pharmacy
 - ✓ Rebate form available on website for commercially insured prescriptions filled at a non-participating pharmacy
 - ✓ Copay savings program for commercially insured (patient may pay as little as \$0 for medication)
 - ✓ Patient assistance program for Medicare, Medicaid, and uninsured (medication provided at no cost to patient)

 - ✓ Provides medication free of charge to eligible individuals, primarily the uninsured, some exceptions to insurance criteria may apply in special circumstances (see website for details)
 - **Veklury** [Advancing Access-Gilead] 800-226-2056 www.gilead.com/purpose/medication-access/us-patient-access
 - ✓ Provides copay support for eligible patients with commercial insurance
 - ✓ Cannot be used with government funded insurance

 - Patient support program provides education and financial support
 - Limited to Gilead brand products
 - Must meet income eligibility requirements (see website for more details)
 - Patient must have commercial insurance
- 5) **GoodRX** 855-268-2822 www.goodrx.com
 - Program covers brand and generic medications at discounted prices
 - Can be used instead of insurance, but cannot be combined with any insurance
 - GoodRX coupons can be generated from the website or mobile application

- Physical card can also be requested via mail
 - Free and no membership required (exception: premium membership program)
 - Premium membership offers even greater savings and discounted virtual care visits, automatically renews (see website for more details)

- Qualifications (see website for more details):
 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ Must be uninsured or have Medicare Part D
 - ✓ Patients with commercial insurance may be eligible to receive oncology and specialty products
 - ✓ Medicare Part D patients must provide proof of out of pocket payments of \$600 in prescription expenses for the year
 - ✓ No age requirement
 - Coverage is limited to GSK products
 - Medications provided at no cost to the patient
 - Coverage available for GSK vaccines in patients 18 years or older with no insurance
 - Coupons and free trial options also available for some GSK products
 - Enrollment for 1 year, can re-enroll annually if still eligible

- Non-profit organization that provides financial assistance to help with prescription copays, behavioral health services, pediatric treatment costs, travel costs, and health insurance premiums, deductibles, and coinsurance
 - Assistance provided through funds for certain diseases
 - New diseases are added every year
 - A grant must be submitted to receive assistance
 - Qualifications (see website for more details):
 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ Must have some form of health insurance that covers part of the cost of treatment
 - ✓ Must have a disease listed under open disease funds and be on an eligible treatment
 - Grant remains active for 12 months or until grant amount is exhausted
 - Must re-enroll annually if still eligible and funding available

 - Coverage is limited to Janssen products
 - Options available for patients with commercial, government funded, or no insurance

- Qualifications (see website for more details):
 - ✓ No age requirement
 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ Patient must be uninsured
 - Medications provided at no cost to the patient
 - 1 year enrollment period, can re-enroll annually if still eligible

- Qualifications (see website for more details):

- ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ No age requirement
 - ✓ Patient must be uninsured, have Medicare Part D, and/or Medicare Part B (if oncology products)
 - Coverage limited to Lilly brand products
 - Medications provided at no cost to patient
 - 1 year enrollment, can re-enroll annually if still eligible

- Helps individuals with limited income and resources pay for Medicare drug coverage (Part D) premiums, deductibles, coinsurance, and other costs
 - Certain individuals will automatically receive Extra Help (see website for details)
 - Qualifications:
 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ Must be enrolled in a Medicare prescription drug plan
 - Enrollment is automatic and continuous based on eligibility

- Includes directory of patient assistance programs that provide free or reduced cost medications
 - Determines eligibility and directs the user to programs that will be the most beneficial

- Qualifications (see website for details):
 - ✓ No age requirement
 - ✓ Certain income requirements
 - Copay savings cards available for commercially insured
 - Patient assistance program offers free medication to eligible individuals
 - Provides Merck vaccines free of charge to eligible adults
 - Hospital Product Replacement Program helps indigent and uninsured patients replace certain Intravenously administered medications
 - 1 year enrollment, may reapply as many times as needed

- Non-profit organization that connects people to programs that will help them afford their medication and other healthcare costs
 - Alphabetical lists of Prescription Assistance Programs
 - Frequently updated
 - NeedyMeds Drug Discount card available – may offer discount on over-the-counter drugs

 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ No age requirement
 - Coverage is limited to Novartis products
 - Novartis medications provided at no cost to patient
 - 1 year enrollment, can re-enroll annually if still eligible

- Offers assistance to patients who are being treated for diabetes, obesity, hemophilia, and growth disorder

- Limited to Novo brand products
 - Copay savings cards available for commercially insured patients
 - Patient assistance program offers free medications to eligible individuals
 - Cannot be used with government funded insurance

- Offers financial assistance to patients with certain cancers, chronic illnesses, and rare diseases
 - Assistance provided through funds for certain diseases
 - Assistance includes covering out-of-pocket and medical expenses such as copays, health insurance premiums, and transportation costs
 - A grant must be submitted to receive assistance
 - Qualifications (see website for more details)
 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ Must be receiving treatment for a disease listed under disease funds
 - ✓ Must be prescribed a medication that is listed as a covered medication for disease fund
 - ✓ Have health insurance that covers qualifying medication
 - Grant remains active for 12 months or until grant amount is exhausted
 - Must re-enroll annually if still eligible and funding available

- Qualifications (see website for more details):
 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ No age requirement
 - ✓ Must be uninsured or have government funded insurance
 - ✓ Commercially insured patients are ineligible
 - Coverage is limited to Pfizer products (Pfizer vaccines included)
 - Pfizer medications provided at no cost to patient
 - Co-pay and savings cards also available on website
 - 1 year enrollment period

- ✓ Qualifications (see website for more details)
 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ Limited to Otsuka brand products
 - ✓ Enrollment lasts for 1 year Patients who have government issued insurance must re-apply every year by December 31st.
 - ✓ Patients without insurance must re-apply every 12 months

 - Determines eligibility and directs the user to programs that will be the most beneficial
 - Printable RxAssist savings card on homepage

- Qualifications (see website for more details)
 - ✓ Must meet income eligibility requirements
 - ✓ No age requirements
 - Medications provided at a discount (certain medications free on first come, first serve basis)
 - Enrollment lasts for 1 year, patients are automatically re-enrolled

- Qualifications (see website for details):
 - ✓ Must be a resident of Alabama
 - ✓ At least 55 years old with a chronic medical condition and have no prescription drug insurance or limited prescription drug insurance
 - ✓ Any age with a disability (deemed disabled by social security or have applied for disability and awaiting a decision, have a doctor's declaration of disability, or in the 24 month Medicare coverage waiting period)
 - ✓ Have Medicare and in Medicare Part D coverage gap
- Certain income limit requirements
