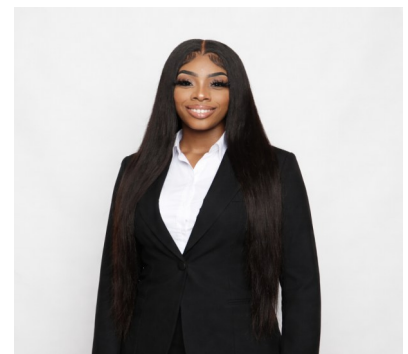
The 310 Board family is excited to begin this new chapter under her leadership.
